TRAVEL THROUGH TIME

Founder Ludwig Krieghoff was already a pioneer in his time. His insight "You shoot with the barrel, you hit with the stock"® is firmly rooted in the traditional manufactory. It forms the basis for the patented Krieghoff custom stock method.

Heinrich Krieghoff, Ludwig Krieghoff's son founds the company "Heinrich Krieghoff", also in Suhl.

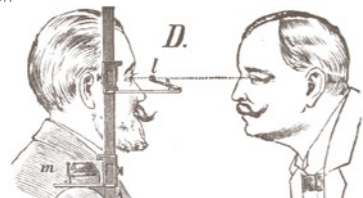


1905

Krieghoff's first adjustable insert barrel is patented.

1886

Ludwig Krieghoff, together with a partner, founds the "Sempert & Krieghoff" in Suhl, Thuringia.



1900

"You shoot with the barrels you hit with the stock"® this finding by Ludwig Krieghoff leads to the patented Krieghoff stock measurement principle.

1906

A pneumatic device to prevent "doubling" on drillings with a single trigger is presented.

1926-1930

The first over-and-under combination rifle/shotgun with manual cocking and de-cocking slide is presented. Krieghoff manufactures the world's first lugless shotgun.

1925

Krieghoff is the world's first manufacturer to introduce the lightweight Dural as a material in hunting weapon construction.

1919

The companies "Sempert & Krieghoff" and "Heinrich Krieghoff" are merged under Heinrich Krieghoff's direction.

1932

Krieghoff's semi-automatic rifle with gas-operated loading mechanism and block action debuts.

1956

Patent for a safety catch for breech action guns.

1950

After the end of World War II, Krieghoff starts again in Ulm with 13 employees.

1960

The company moves into its present-day production site in Ulm's industrial area.

1957

Krieghoff presents its first competition shotgun: the K-32.

1966

Kenneth A. Jones (USA) becomes Trap World Champion with his Krieghoff K-32.

Patent for free-floating barrels for combination guns.

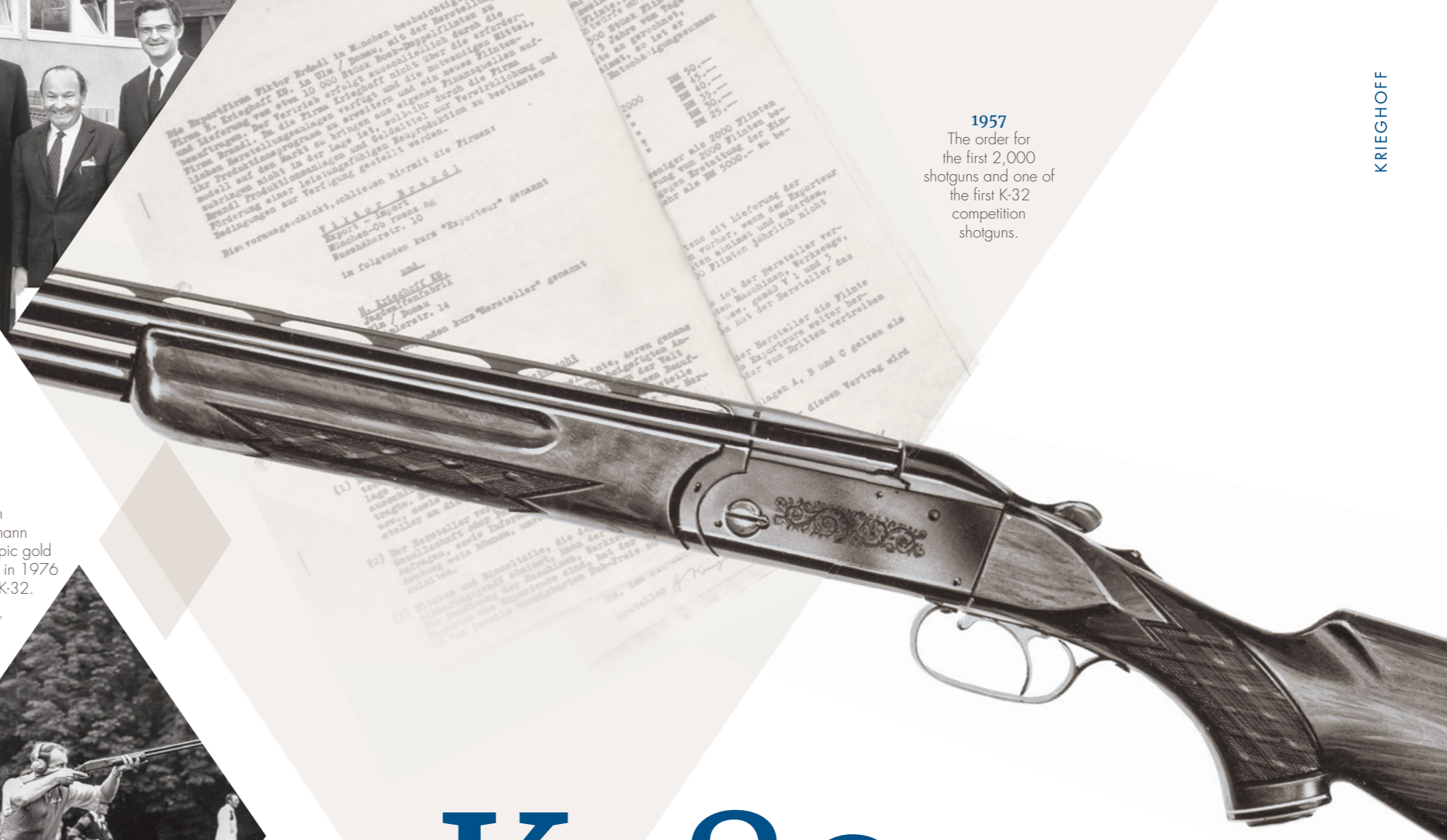

A SUCCESS STORY

◆◆ The K-80's legendary reputation is no coincidence. Krieghoff's very first shotgun, the K-32, helped build its foundation through our continuous design optimization over several decades. Remington developed the Model 32, a true competition shotgun, in the 1930s, but suspended manufacturing the complex firearm soon after its introduction. L.M.Donaldson, Trapshooting champion several times over, traveled to Germany bringing with him the idea of a perfect competition shotgun. In Krieghoff he found the gunsmith expertise he had sought for so long. The basic design of the Remington 32 was used as the starting point for the Ulm-based gunmakers' inaugural shotgun project. Inviting Krieghoff shooters to exchange their ideas and experience with the company further expanded after Dieter Krieghoff emigrated to North America in 1979 and later founded Krieghoff International, Inc. It was just such dialogue that led to the development of the K-80, an enhanced version of the K-32.

K-SYSTEM THE MODULAR SYSTEM

To this day, the concept of the Krieghoff competition shotguns is based on the optimal adaptation of the firearm to the individual requirements of the shooter and of the chosen discipline. The principle of interchangeability and modular systems make this possible.



ACTION

The K-80 breech has a reputation for being indestructible through proving time and time again that they easily fire over a million rounds outperforming competitive shotguns. Perfectly balanced with a far forward hinge, the breech plate lever is positioned for optimal ergonomics allowing an easy opening, yet ruggedly designed breach with a perfect weight and balance feel.

TRIGGER SYSTEM

The mechanical trigger of the K-80 is special: in the event of a misfire, the weapon still switches over and the 2nd shot can be fired safely.



STOCKS

K-80 Stocks, optimally designed from comb to pistol grip palm swell to suit each type of shooting sport, perfectly meet each shooter's individual needs. Adjustable comb stocks designed for an intuitive and consistent fit come standard on K-80 models. All stocks feature fine checkering, and are available in true right- and left-handed configuration. Custom stocks are an optional upgrade.

CHOKES

Conventional fixed chokes or screw-in titanium choke tubes are available for the K-80. Titanium chokes feature clearly marked constrictions on their knurled ends and can be replaced quickly. Nine constrictions, from Cylinder to Super Full, are available for all choke tube sets. Thin-walled screw-in chokes in either flush mount or extended styles are available options for the Parcours models.



BARRELS

Barrels are offered in standard lengths: 28", 30", 32", and 34" (71 cm, 76 cm, 81 cm and 86 cm). The free-floating barrel design offers the ability to adjust the point of impact. The Parcours model with its light weight, hard-soldered barrel is the exception. All points of contact on the barrel set are hard-soldered to maximize durability and service life. The chambers are chromed to maximize their life. The long forcing cone reduces the recoil felt by the shooter. The inside profile of the barrel ensures an even pattern and maximizes the speed of the shot column. Most 12 gauge and 20 gauge configurations of the K-80 and K-20 lines are steel-shot proofed.

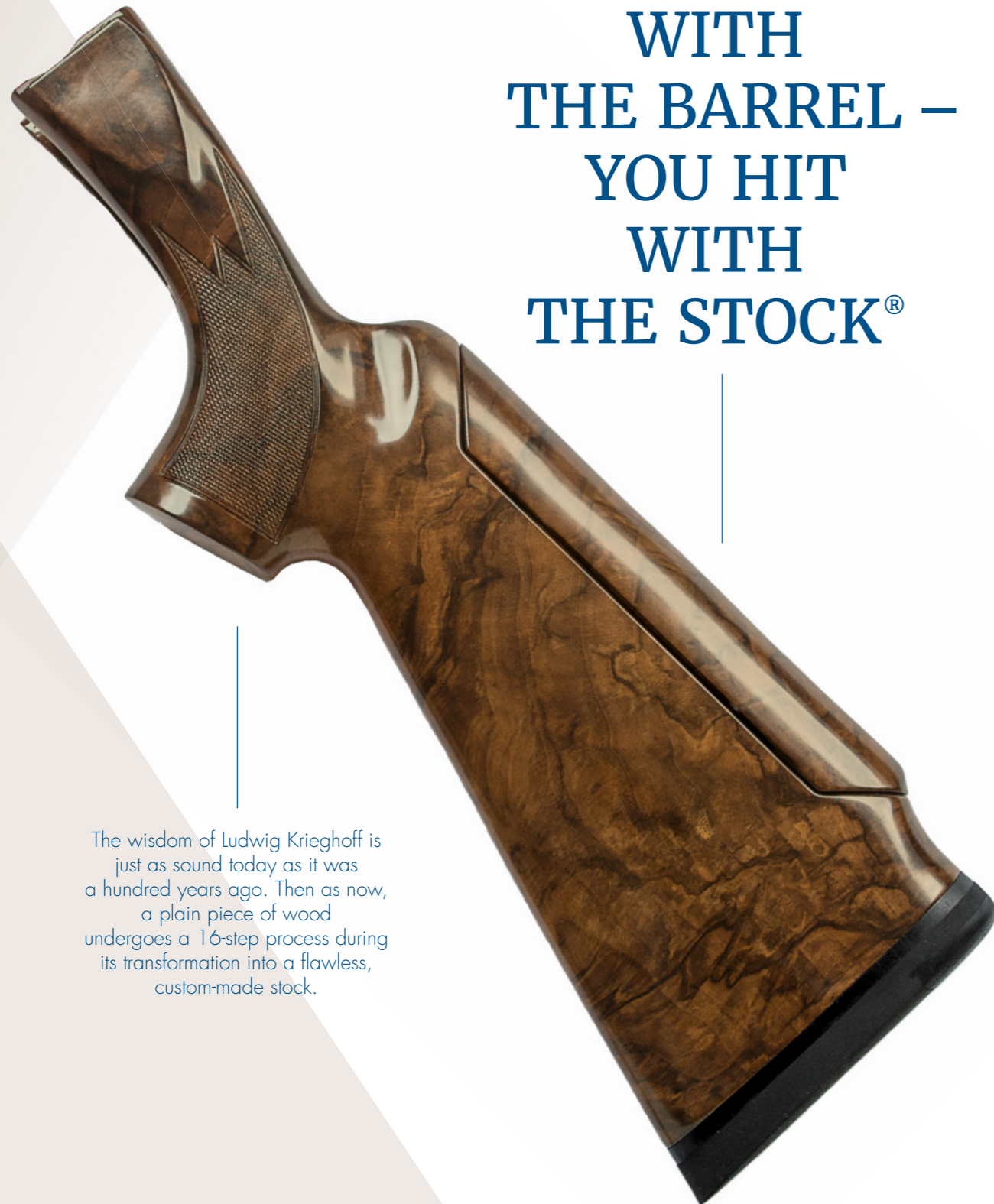

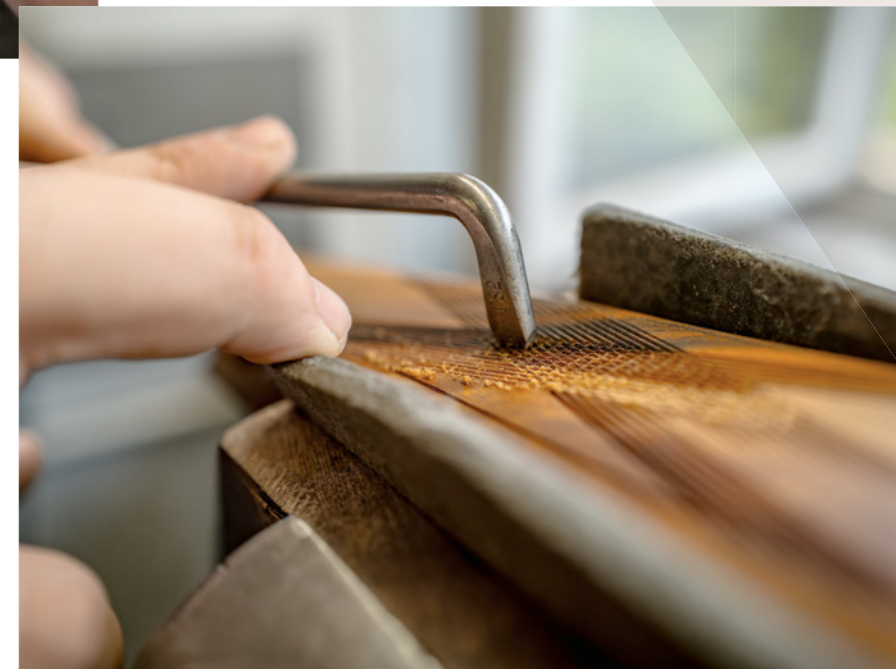


The wisdom of Ludwig Krieghoff is just as sound today as it was a hundred years ago. Then as now, a plain piece of wood undergoes a 16-step process during its transformation into a flawless, custom-made stock.



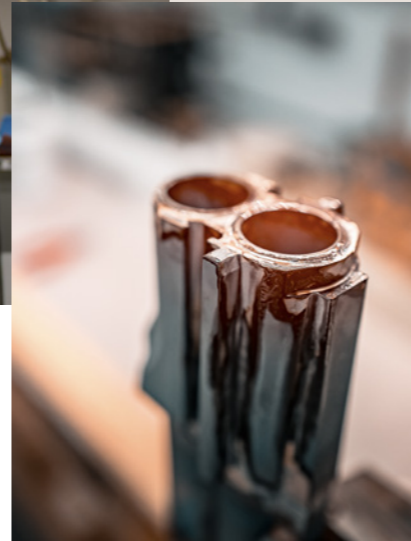
GUNSTOCK MAKER

◆◆ To visualize how best to design the stock from a blank in its raw form, how the composition and grain can be best utilized to maximize strength and beauty, is the essence of the boldness and flair of an experienced stock maker. Before shaping the stock, the wood category must be selected. It takes about eighty years of growth before a stock can be made from the wood of a walnut tree. During this time, nature creates an ever-unique and noble grain that speaks to the senses like almost no other material. Once the final shape has emerged from the chiseling and filing, and the stock has been seamlessly fitted to the receiver, finely carved checkering and surface finishing complete the work of art. Classic oiling or epoxying – both methods uniquely enhance the natural beauty of the wood. The end result is a stock that is a pleasure to hold and behold.
